Term: Summer 2025

Art

In Art, the children will be studying the works of famous artists such as Picasso, Joan Miro, Piet Mondrian and Steve Brown and having a go at creating a piece of work in their style.

DT

The children will be using their skills to design, create and evaluate an electrical poster.

French

The children will be continuing their French this term. They will be learning to say who lives in their family, order simple items from a café and give simple directions.

PSHE

We will be covering two topics 'Relationships' and 'Changing me'. The children will be discussing things such as Jealousy, getting on and falling out.

We will begin discussing the topic of puberty and how our bodies change during this time.

We will also be discussing how our feelings and emotions might change during this time.

Music

We will be looking at Minimalism in music. The children will be looking at rhythmic displacement and creating their own rhythmic and melodic motifs to displace.

We will then be looking at rivers and representing them using pitch and compositional skills

Maths

We will be delving into the following concepts:

- Decimals
- Money
- Time
- Statistics
- Properties of Shape
- Position and Direction

We will also be regularly practising tables and revising prior knowledge.

English

We start the term by using Disney's 'fear' to create a retell. The children will be continuing to use different skills to enhance their writing.

We will then be linking our topic learning to our writing by writing a diary entry of a Viking. We will be using our knowledge gained on the school trips.

Throughout the term, we will be practising our handwriting and improving presentation throughout our books.

History

Our focus this term will be The Vikings. We will look at the Vikings were, Danegeld, Viking life and Laws and justice. The children will be going on a trip to Ufton Court to further their knowledge on this topic.

Geography

Our focus for this term will be weather and climate. The children will explore what is meant by weather and climate. We will then collect weather data and learn how to present the most efficient way.

RE

This term, the children will be learning why people go to Church in our Christianity topic and will be discussing what is the best way for a Jew to lead a good life.

Computing

Part one of our term will be focused on 'Creative Media' and effective use of Photo editing.

Part two of our term will be focused on 'Programming' and creating games in Scratch.

Science

In part one we will be looking at how to construct a simple electric circuit, naming all the basic parts needed. Children will explore switches and create their own electrical poster. In part two we will be learning how living things can be grouped in a variety of ways and explore keys to help with classification.
