Over the last week at Beechwood......

Foundation Stage had a wonderful time at their Sports Day! All of the adults in Butterflies were so proud of the children for trying their best and being great team players! We hope that all of our families had lots of fun at the family picnic and watching the events. In maths we have been learning about shape patterns and rotating shapes to make pictures. In our topic lessons we have been learning about different under water habitats.

Years 1 & 2 have been writing their stories of St George and The Dragon, Year 1 have looked at speech bubbles and Year 2 have been focusing on writing for dramatic effect. We have been enjoying practising for sports day and had a fantastic day yesterday showing you all. In maths, Year 1 have been recognising and counting money and Year 2 have been having lots of fun creating tally charts and pictograms.

Year 3 had a fantastic time at sports day and showed some excellent sportsmanship. In english they have been learning about instruction texts in order to write about their DT project this week. In DT, they have designed their own Greek inspired bread and are looking forward to making this and bringing it home!

Year 4 are beginning their final maths topic of the year: position and direction, we will be working with coordinates and translating simple shapes. In english, we continue our narrative journey. In geography we are thinking about the sorts of industries that are located in the UK, and how these have an impact on the development of the physical environment. In P.E. we will be continuing our work on tennis. PSHE sees the next lesson on Changing Me: Circles of Change. In R.E. we continue learning about the beliefs of Humanism. The children are enjoying their science work on the classification of living things.

Year 5 have continued to focus on the local area and how it meets the needs of the people living in Woodley in geography. In maths, they have been learning to compare and order negative numbers. Yesterday, the children were all amazing during Sports Day, and supported each other during events. We are very proud of them all.


