Over the last week at Beechwood......

Foundation Stage have met a real Pirate - Pirate Pete! He told us all about what life is like as a pirate; what pirates need to wear, what they have to eat on board a ship and the rules they have to follow! We have also been learning about the oceans of the world and have been locating them on maps. In maths, we have revisited our learning on the composition of numbers to 10 and have been practising recalling our numberbonds to 5.

Years 1 & 2 have been writing their story of the Paper Bag Princess with an alternative ending. Year 2 have continued to work really hard in their SATS and just have 1 left tomorrow, well done Year 2! In science this week we learnt about the different types of clouds and how clouds are formed, we then had a go at making clouds using warm water, glass jars and ice cubes.

Year 3 have been using magnets in science to investigate which materials are magnetic. In english they have begun to write crime reports after Miss Fowler's special pot went missing! Finally, In art they have been learning to sketch aspects of the face.

Year 4 have been completing their unit on poetry and have been looking at symmetrical shapes in maths. In PE we continue our work on tennis and athletics, in geography we have been looking at physical features such as rivers and mountains. Owls have also worked hard on their assembly this week. In PSHE we have been looking at how babies are made.

Year 5 are finishing their unit on debates this week, writing their own balanced argument on whether graffiti is vandalism or art. In art, they have been creating pieces of work inspired by graffiti artist Keith Haring. During PE, the children learnt how to triple jump.


