Foundation Stage have been learning about bees. They have made egg box and playdoh bees. In maths sessions they have learnt about sharing and grouping. In english they have been thinking about bee related questions. On Friday afternoon we will be visited by a Beekeeper where these questions can be answered and we will find out other bee related facts.


Years 1 & 2 are writing fact files about all the different jobs in a castle, they have loved finding out lots of information and are doing a great job of writing it down. In maths Year 1 have started fractions and Year 2 are recapping addition and subtraction. In PE this half term, Year 1 and 2 have really enjoyed completing their net and wall unit, finishing the unit with playing a great game of tennis on Monday afternoon. The Year 1 and 2 team wish you all a lovely half term.

Year 3 have finished writing their fantastic news reports, having reported on the story of King Midas and the Golden Touch. In computing they have discussed how desktop publishing is used in the world. In maths, they have been learning to solve problem solving questions on time. Finally, in science they have been designing their own balanced meals to finish off their "animals including humans" topic.

Year 4 will be completing their unit on 'Electricity' by researching ways to create electricity that are eco-friendly. In art, the children will be using oil pastels to create their very own 'McCoo' in the style of Steven Brown. In maths, the children will continue learning their times tables. The children have used the 'have a go' feature of the real test and we will be using this a few more times before the real thing in June.

Year 5 are finishing off their unit on play scripts in english this week. In art they have completed their final assessment piece, creating a Tudor style portrait of themselves and in music, they have continued to focus on Melodies of Divinity. Please could pupils keep any spare non-stretchy clothes they no longer need that might be being thrown out? During design technology (DT) week next half term, the fabric from these garments will be upcycled into cuddly animals to take home. There will be a small choice to make from animal patterns.

Year 6 spent the week being absolutely amazing! They worked incredibly hard during their SATs and all the staff have complimented the children on how impeccable their behaviour was. We loved our celebration at Woodford Park too! This week we will be concentrating on English - looking at the poem 'The Dreadful Menace'.
