Over the last week at Beechwood......

Foundation Stage have been learning about spiders and ants. They have made a spider and it's web. In maths sessions they have continued to learn the order of numbers to 20 and how they are represented. In english they have acted out the story of the "The Enormous Turnip".

Years 1 & 2 have been enjoying learning about Jack and The Beanstalk, this week they are going to be writing the story, innovating parts of it. In history we have been learning about William The Conqueror and how he became king, we have also been learning the different parts of a castle. In computing we have been really enjoying using the Ipads to create digital music using Chrome Music Lab.

Year 3 have finished their maths topic on money and have begun to look at time, learning how to read roman numeral clocks. In art, they enjoyed sketching Greek artefacts while in geography they looked at some of the issues currently being faced by the people living in Greece. Finally, in english they have been looking at news reports in preparation of writing their own.

Year 4 are continuing their 'suspense' stories, focusing on using subordinate clauses, fronted adverbials, and a range of conjunctions. In maths, we continue learning about money. The children will be adding and subtracting amounts of money whilst using their problem solving skills. In science, we will be learning about the role that a switch plays in an electrical circuit. We thank you in advance for your donations to our 'Penny Wars' over the next few weeks.

Year 5 have started studying Macbeth in reading and english, as part of their playscript unit. In art, the children have continued their Tudor portraits, but with a twist - they had to draw them while laying upside down! In French, the children have been learning words for different body parts.


Year 6 have been busy learning and revising for their upcoming SATs. In addition to revising, we have been completing our independent writing in english - we have either written a live blog or a traditional newspaper report based on Junko Tabei (first woman to conquer Everest). The children have worked really hard on this and it has shown in their writing. We have also been learning about Katsushika Hokusai, one of Japan's greatest artists and innovators of Ukiyo-e printmaking in Art. We will start printing next week!
