Dear Parents/Guardians,

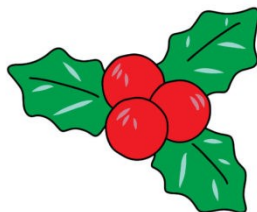

**Over the last week at Beechwood, and looking forward.....**

*Foundation Stage— Butterflies have been busy doing their nativity and can't wait to show you all tomorrow. We have also been learning about winter and the signs of winter we see as the seasons change from Autumn to Winter. In drawing club, we have been doing the story stick man and drawing the character of stick man having a go at writing the word 'man'. We have also been very busy with lots of Christmas crafts!*

*Year 1— This week in Maths we have finished our unit on 2D and 3D shapes. Next week we will be consolidating the learning we have done this term. In English we will do a drawing club on a Christmas story. Robins have started their Design Technology project last week, they have been designing a woodland animal puppet. This week they will start making it by combining materials and using simple running stitch.*

*Year 2— In Year 2, we wrote predictions about what was in Harvey Slumfenburger's Christmas present and used adverbs to describe the different ways Santa travelled back to the North Pole. In Maths we continued our unit of addition and subtraction. For our Design and Technology unit the children tasted and evaluated different types of bread before enjoying a super, sticky time making their own bread! We have also been rehearsing our nativity play which Foxes class are excited to perform next week.*

*Year 3— In Year 3, we have been practising our Christmas carols for the annual church service, which will be held next week. In English, we have been focusing on punctuating our writing accurately and using adventurous vocabulary to up level our work. In Maths, we took part in a practical lesson on sharing and grouping as part of our multiplication and division unit. Later this week, we will be completing our DT Stone Age houses using 3D net paper models.*

*Year 4— Year 4 have loved their time at Palmers Park Pool and Tuesday was their last swimming lesson this term. Everyone has made brilliant progress and we can't wait to come back! Christmas has finally come to Year 4 and our Christmas decorations are up - and how wonderful they look too! In English, we have been spotting Santa live on Santa-Cam, to give us ideas for writing a setting description. In Maths we have been looking at shapes, compass directions and right angles.*

*Year 5— Year 5 had a fantastic trip to Winchester Science Museum this week. They explored their science topics of space and forces. Excitingly in Design Technology, they have explored designing and making a themed Christmas pop up book.*

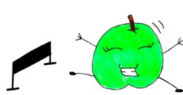
*Year 6— Year 6 are continuing to write flashback stories based on WW1, students have been focusing on emotive language and use of semi colons in our writing. Within Maths, Mr Hamilton's class has moved on to measures and converting between measures, while Miss Hill's class have been adding and subtracting mixed numbers.
