Our topic for the term is 'Earth's Lungs,' learning all about the rainforest

We will learn about their location, climate, structure and contribution to Earth's climate. We will also consider the effects of deforestation.

Art and DT

We will be using acrylic paints to create a colourful rainforest picture inspired by John Dyer (Eden Project) and his visit to the Yawanawa Tribe in the Amazon rainforest and designing a moving animal in DT.

History

In history we will look at the Kayapo tribe in the Amazon rainforest and the famous rainforest explorer Francisco de Orellana.

<u>French</u>

We will be looking at our classrooms to name items in our surroundings and what we do in these locations and different foods.

PSHE

We will continue to follow the Jigsaw programme, with the unit 'Dreams and Goals.' This will encompass recognising and overcoming challenges.

RE

This term, the children will be learning about Miracles in a unit on Christianity, before moving onto learning the Easter story.

English

We will begin each day with RWI phonics or whole class reading. The books we will be reading are 'My Name Is River' and 'Animal Atlas' (Non Fiction). We will develop our writing skills through persuasive writing, fact files and reports and continue to develop our spelling, punctuation and grammar knowledge through Spag lessons.

Music

In music we will be continuing to learn a variety of songs and develop our musicianship based on the topic 'in the garden.'

Term: Spring 2025

<u>Maths</u>

Year 2 will be learning

Money Recognising coins, Making amounts and finding change. Multiplication and measuring length and height.

Year 3 will be completing units

Multiplication and Division

There will be a focus on knowledge of times tables, as we move onto applying this to multiplying and dividing 2 digit numbers.

Measurement Looking at length, perimeter, mass and capacity.

Fractions Children will look at fractions, what they are and how we use them.

Computing

In computing we will be looking at branching databases and using scratch, a programming software to create a musical instrument.

PE/Games

In outdoor PE this term we will be looking at the sports of netball and tag rugby. In indoor PE we will be looking at gymnastics and yoga.

<u>Science</u>

Our topic this term is **Plants**. The children will learn the different parts of a plant, what they need to grow and the process of pollination.
