## Summer Overview



French

Bonjour! The children will continue to build upon their progress in the French language. This will include parts of the body, family celebrations and simple sentences.

PE/Games

Lessons are outdoors and take place on Tuesdays and Fridays. The first half term we will be golf and cricket skills and then in the final half term, athletics, which will involve lots of running, jumping and throwing activities.

English

We will begin each day with whole class reading, starting with an adventure story called Atticus. We will be exploring our first unit of Talk for writing. Our featured text will be "I'll take you to Mrs Cole!" We will Imitate, Innovate and Invent by ending off with an independent write. We will be exploring story maps, poetry, adventurous vocabulary and setting description.

PSHE

We will continue to follow the Jigsaw programme, with the units 'Relationships' and then 'Changing Me.' This will include how we can keep positive connections with others and also how babies grow over time.

Science

Our first topic will be **Materials and their properties**

- identifying and comparing the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses

We continue our topic of **Animals in the second half of the term**, learning to classify animals and how they get nutrition.
