Overview of this Term

During Spring term, we are going to be explorers, travelling all around the world learning about lots of different countries. We will start off our exciting adventure with an airport experience day, then our first stop will be Italy and making pizza! We will then go on to visit: Pakistan, China, Kenya and finish with the Arctic. We will be exploring culture and traditions in each country as well as exploring and comparing our life in the UK.

Communication and Language

During this term the children will continue to develop their communication skills and we will start to explore how to speak using more complex sentences. We will continue to explore lots of stories, including acting them out. We will also continue to sing lots of songs and rhymes.

Physical Development

In PE this term we will be completing a unit of dance, we will explore with lots of different movements to music. We will also look at traditional dances in the countries that we are going to visit. This unit will help us to develop our coordination and balance. We will also be completing a range of fine motor activities through play as well as using our outdoor area for our gross motor development and our core exercises.

Literacy



The children will continue in their own Read Write Inc groups for phonics lessons, the children will be learning set 1 single letter sounds and special friends (ch, th, sh etc). Please look out for more information if your child has moved to ditty group. All children are receiving reading books suitable to where they are on their reading journey, we thank you in your support and engagement with this. In Literacy we will continue to use drawing club to help us do lots of super writing, we will now start to write captions and simple sentences.

Mathematics

We have now learnt in depth about the numbers to 5 and we will start spring by looking at 0 and what this means. We will then recap our numbers to 5 increasing our confidence in composition and finding one more and one less before moving onto exploring the numbers 6, 7 and 8. We will also explore mass and capacity.

Understanding the World

Our Understanding the World carpet times will mainly focus on each country we are going to explore, looking at culture, traditions, food and life in those countries and comparing them to the UK. This term we will also be looking at Winter and seasonal changes as well as forces such as push and pull. Personal, Social and Emotional Development

During Spring we will be revisiting our learning related to our consent curriculum and social skills. In Jigsaw carpet sessions we will be learning about 'Dreams and Goals', exploring what it means to set goals and overcome challenges along the way.

Expressive Arts and Design

Children will have daily opportunities to express themselves creatively. During free-flow time they will be able to choose from a variety of resources such as paint, junk modelling, collage and drawing materials. We will also be exploring traditional art from the countries we are exploring, such as truck art in Pakistan.
