We are looking forward to starting some exciting new units of work!

Art and DT

The children will be given the opportunity to discover and develop a range of techniques in DT. In Art, we will design and create Greek pots using clay. We will also sketch and model Greek buildings.

French

Bonjour! The children will continue to build upon their progress in the French language. This will include parts of the body, clothes and simple sentences.

<u>English</u>

We will begin each day with whole class reading, starting with a non-fiction text about Ancient Greece and then moving on to an adventure story called Atticus.

Our first unit is Greek Myths, where we will explore the language and structures of these memorable stories. We will then move on to newspaper reports and poetry. Key Spellings and handwriting will also be a regular class focus.

Geography

As our topic this term is Ancient Greece, our geography unit is all about the fascinating country of Greece as it is today. We will learn the location of Greece, its landscape and uses, climate and culture.

<u>History</u>

Our topic for the term is 'Ancient Greece,' learning all about the society, arts and culture of this fascinating ancient era. We will learn about how they lived, their many gods and myths, and the Olympic Games.
