

Term: Summer 2

Religious Education

In RE, we will be continuing to explore the topic of Islam and looking to answer the question:
Does belief in Akhirah (life after death) help Muslims lead good lives?

History

We are looking at the changing power of the Monarchy through the ages; in particular looking at Charles II, Elizabeth I and Charles III. We will look into the differences of 'absolute' monarchy and 'constitutional' monarchy.

Music

Taking inspiration from electrical circuits and symbols, pupils explore pulse, beat, rhythm and notation, writing and performing their own rhythm grid music. Pupils listen to some of the ways music was created using electricity during the first half of the 20th century.

English

Writing

We will still be focussing on independent writing but this term will be all about the theme of 'Change'. We will be thinking about how change affects us and reading 'All the things that could go wrong' by Stewart Foster. We will have a focus on playscripts, instructions and emotive pieces.

Maths

We will be focussing on problem solving activities and concentrating on life skills associated with maths. We will also be using our math skills to fundraise for our Leavers Evening!

Computing

Computing systems and networks – communication and collaboration

We will understand computer networks, including the internet; how they can provide multiple services, such as the World Wide Web, and the opportunities they offer for communication and collaboration. We will also use technology safely, respectfully and responsibly; recognise acceptable/unacceptable behaviour; identify a range of ways to report concerns about content and contact.

Science

This term, we are continuing to explore electricity, through electrical circuits. This topic will continue through until the end of the school year, ending with our own Dragon's Den!

In Physical Education, we will be focusing on athletics and sports day preparation.
