



**Over the last week at Beechwood, and looking forward.....**

*Foundation Stage — Butterflies have concluded their unit on our everyday superheroes by looking at doctors and were very lucky to have a visit from a doctor today who showed us how to bandage our teddies. In Drawing Club this week, we have been using the text 'Zog and The Flying Doctors', drawing and writing about the character Zog as well as making our own magic medicine. Next week we will be learning all about Spring and Easter.*

*Year 1— This week in Maths we have started with Place value to 50. In Science the children tested different objects in the classroom and sorted them into magnetic and non-magnetic. In Music they recognised the relationship between dot notation (3 different notes) and movement of pitch. And in Geography we learnt names and features of seasons of the year.*

*Year 2— In Year 2 this week we have independently written The Elephant's child and are now planning our own 'Just so' style story about how an animal gets its feature. In maths we have been doubling and halving numbers and are now learning our 5 and 10 times tables. In Science we looked at the changes and signs of spring and in Geography we learned about different climates near the equator and at the poles.*

*Year 3— This week in Science, Year 3 have been investigating forces and magnets, exploring how different forces work and how magnets attract and repel. In Maths, we have been focusing on measuring, developing our skills and understanding of different units. In English, the children have begun their narrative writing, inspired by Tarzan and the theme of saving the rainforest. They have been coming up with some imaginative ideas and exciting story openings. During our multiplication sessions, we have been practising the 4 times tables. The children are doing a fantastic job remembering their tables, and we are proud to have a few uplevelled players in TT Rockstars! Keep up the great work, Year 3!*

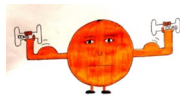
*Year 4— This week, Year 4 have finished looking at the structure of a narrative story and will now be planning their own story where a lonely character faces a problem which he tries to solve himself and yet finds his community only too ready to help. In Maths, we will be writing tenths as decimals and finding tenths on a number line. In Science, we are continuing to learn about electricity and this week we will be building more circuits and experimenting with using lamps in series. Lastly, please remember to keep practicing TTRS at least three times a week!*

*Year 5— Year 5 have been out and about on their bikes this week! Well done to all those that took part - it looked fun! We have also been looking at Statistics in maths - we're now experts at line graphs! We will be starting a new topic in English of Newspaper Reporting - any donations of old newspapers would be gratefully received!*

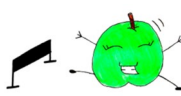
